Dotted Quaver (Eighth Note) and Semiquaver (Sixteenth Note)



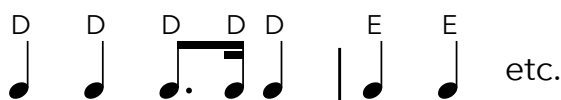
As you clap the *quick - er* rhythm pattern , make sure not to cut short the dotted quaver!

Activities

- 4) With another violinist, try **playing** an ascending scale, one note to a bar, with the second person coming in a line later.
