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Try this with a metronome using a slow dotted crotchet beat to start with. Make a clear difference between "quick-e-ty" and "quick-er, and".

Activities

- 1) **Clap** lines 1 and 2 and **say** the rhythm names at the same time.
- 2) One person **claps** line 1 while another **claps** line 2, both **saying** the rhythm names.
- 3) **Clap** lines 3 and 4.
- 4) One person **claps** line 3 while another **claps** line 4. **Swap** over.
- 5) **Clap** 4 parts together, if there are enough people!
- 6) **Copy** line 1 below:

How to clap the dotted minim

After clapping the first syllable ('slow'), **keep your hands together**, then make a downward movement to show where the 2nd beat 'ow' comes.
